Our Market is providing a large quantity of groceries to families who need it as soaring food prices increase the necessity for many to supplement their food supply. Requests from our students for food bags to take home over the weekend and classroom snacks have surpassed an all-time high. The struggle is real, and countless people and partnering organizations are depending on us. We are woven into the fabric of collaborative partnerships as a way of maximizing the resources we've been given.
